The External Relations Unit for Belgium and Luxembourg is seeking a bilingual French/Dutch intern for six months starting 3 September 2018 and who can commit well in advance. The intern must meet the administrative criteria set out below and have a good command of English, a good comprehension of French and knowledge of the media sector (including social media). Layout and CMS skills are an asset.

#### General description of internship

- Assisting with the organization of events

### Requisite educational and administrative criteria

In order to be considered eligible for an internship, the following criteria must be fulfilled:

- Be a recent graduate or current student in a graduate/undergraduate school, programme from a university or higher education facility accredited by UNESCO;
- Have completed at least two years of undergraduate studies in a field relevant or of interest to the work of the Organization;
- Have no direct family ties with a UNHCR staff member (including Temporary Appointment holder) nor with a member of the Affiliate Workforce.
