Duties and Responsibilities

Under the direct supervision of the Assistant Protection Officer and the overall supervision of the Senior Protection Officer, the incumbent will perform the following duties in his/her area of responsibility:

- 1. Stay abreast of political, social, economic and cultural developments that have an impact on the protection environment.
- 2. Consistently apply International and National Law and applicable UN/UNHCR and IASC policy, standards and codes of conduct.
- 3. Assist in providing comments on existing and draft legislation related to persons of concern.
- 4. Provide advice on protection issues to persons of concern; liaise with competent authorities to ensure the issuance of personal and other relevant documentation.
- 5. Assist in conducting eligibility and status determination for persons of concern.
- 6. Contribute to measures to identify, prevent and reduce statelessness.
- 7. Contribute to a country-level child protection plan as part of the protection strategy.
- 8. Contribute to a country-level education plan as part of the protection strategy.
- 9. Monitor Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for all protection/solutions activities.
- 10. Manage individual protection cases including those on SGBV and child protection. Monitor, and intervene in cases of refoulement, expulsion and other protection incidents.
- 11. Assist in identifying durable solutions for the largest possible number of persons of concern through voluntary repatriation, local integration and where appropriate, resettlement.
- 12. Contribute to the design, implementation and evaluation of protection related AGD based programming with implementing and operational partners.
- 13. Contribute to effective information management through the provision of disaggregated data on populations of concern and their problems.
- 14. Participate in initiatives to capacitate authorities, relevant institutions and NGOs to strengthen national protection related legislation and procedures.
- 15. Perform other duties as required.



Qualifications/Requirements

Education: Minimum completion of secondary education but preferably a university degree in Law, Political Science, Social Welfare or related discipline.

Cross – Functional Competencies: Analytical Thinking; Political Awareness; Stakeholder Management

Managerial Competencies: Judgment and Decision Making

Experience: Six (6) years work experience in a similar area or in the wider human rights field. Experience working in a multi-cultural environment or international context is an asset.

Nationality: Citizen of Indonesia; non-citizen with Indonesian permanent residence.

Languages: Excellent knowledge of English and Bahasa Indonesia (written and oral) highly essential; knowledge of other UN languages is an asset.

Desirable Skills: Good written and oral communication skills; computer literacy; good knowledge of UNHCR's protection mandate; interviewing skills; understanding of international humanitarian, human rights and refugee law; ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
