- 2.2 Administrative/Biographical history** The UNHCR Special Mission in Cyprus was originally established in 1974. UNHCR acted as Coordinator of UN Humanitarian Assistance to Cyprus, providing comprehensive assistance to both the Greek Cypriot and Turkish Cypriot communities through the Special Mission in Cyprus.
- 2.4 Immediate source of acquisition** The records were transferred from UNHCR in Nicosia to UNHCR Archives in January 2000.
- 3.1 Scope and content** The records reflect the central role played by UNHCR as administrator of all UN humanitarian assistance to Cyprus. The records contain general correspondence, as well as project and protection files and include individual case information.
