<b>2.3 Administrative history</b>	UNHCR's activities in Bangkok date back to 1952, the International Labour Office seconded an employee to serve as the UNHCR "correspondent" for Southeast Asia. The UNHCR Branch Office in Bangkok was opened in August 1975 to coordinate assistance activities on behalf of displaced Kampuchians, Laotians and Vietnamese. The office was both country office and a regional office, and between 1991 and 2001, the UNHCR representative in Thailand also served as the Director of the United Nations Border Relief Operation.
