

Note on security arrangements

as of 9 November 2023


All participants, including those with a UN Office at Geneva (UNOG) ID badge, **must register online through the Indico link provided by UNHCR to invited participants**.

Upon verification of their invitation status, participants will be accredited and receive an **electronic event badge containing a QR code**.

Participants will be required to show their electronic event badge on their mobile device at the entrance to **Palexpo**. Alternatively, a printed copy of the QR code may be used.

Participants will have to **pass through security**. Multiple entry points will be established to help direct participants and facilitate their entry in an efficient and timely manner.

SPECIAL PROCEDURES – 13 DECEMBER

Due to the participation of high-level dignitaries on 13 December, heightened security measures will be put in place.

Access to the plenary will be restricted to those in possession of a **plenary badge**.

The venue will open as of 7:00 a.m., and participants attending the plenary session are advised to arrive early in order to avoid long queues.

PLENARY BADGES

The plenary badge will be:

- Physical
- Non-nominative (transferable between delegation members but requires re-entry through security)
- Issued in addition to the electronic Indico event badge

Due to limited seating, plenary badges will be distributed as follows:

- STATES -> 2 per delegation
- ALL OTHER STAKEHOLDERS → 1per delegation / individual

PLENARY BADGES COLLECTION

WHO?

States will be provided with a package of 2 plenary badges each. They may be picked up by a representative of the Permanent Missions, who will be asked to show ID and sign for them.

Other participants based in Geneva may also pick up their plenary badge and will be asked to show ID and sign for it.

Other stakeholders not based in Geneva will receive their plenary badge from their stakeholder focal point.



ENTRY POINTS – 14-15 DECEMBER

On 14 and 15 December, the entry points and access to the venue will change as follows:

- Expedited entry point, lane 1.1: requires only 2 badges (Indico e-badge + UNOG badge).
- Plenary badges no longer needed and may be recycled.
- After passing through security, free circulation within the premises including passage between plenary and high-level event rooms.
- Spillover rooms from 13 November will be converted into rooms for high-level events



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
