

INTRODUCTION

1. This document provides an initial assessment of trends in asylum applications lodged in 29 industrialized countries (25 European countries, Australia, Canada, New Zealand and the United States) during 2001 in comparison with previous years.
2. At the time of publication of this report, Greece and the United Kingdom had provided data for the first nine months of 2001 only. For Italy, only annual data are available. For reasons of comparability, these three countries have been excluded from a number of tables. A comprehensive picture for Europe and the European Union will be established once data for Greece and the United Kingdom has been received (probably towards the end of February 2002).
3. This survey is limited to the number of asylum applications submitted and does not allow, therefore, to determine the number of asylum-seekers and refugees authorized to stay. Statistics on the number of asylum-seekers granted refugee status; those allowed to remain for humanitarian reasons; as well as on refugees resettled from first asylum countries up until 2000 are available from the statistics section of the UNHCR website (<http://www.unhcr.org>). The 2001 data will be made available in the coming months.
4. While Governments are the source of the data, UNHCR is responsible for their compilation, analysis and presentation. Except for Table 1, where UNHCR has estimated the number of asylum applicants in the USA to increase the international comparability, all tables reflect data as provided by Governments. All 2001 data are provisional and subject to change. Some discrepancies may exist between the annual figures established on the basis of the monthly trends provided here and officially published annual data.

ANNUAL TRENDS

6. In 2001, the number of asylum applications submitted in the 13 European Union (EU) member countries for which annual data are available (290,500) increased by less than 1% compared to 2000 (288,200). In the six Central European countries included in this survey (Bulgaria, Czech Rep., Hungary, Romania, Slovakia and Slovenia), the annual number of applications increased by 38%, from 30,500 to 42,100. In the four non-European countries covered here (Australia, Canada, New Zealand and the United States), the annual number of asylum applications rose by some 23% (Table 1).



7. Compared over a three-year period, the number of asylum applications lodged in the 13 EU countries shows a declining trend (-3% from 1999 to 2001), countries in Central Europe experience a strong increase (+76%), whereas the non-European countries are also recording major gains (+65%) (Box 1).

8. Switzerland and Norway are not included in the above regional aggregates. In Switzerland, the number of asylum-seekers increased by 18% in 2001 compared

to 2000, but fell by 55% compared to 1999. In Norway, the number of applications in 2001 increased by 36% compared to 2000 and by 46% compared to 1999.

9. In three asylum countries the number of asylum claims submitted in 2001 more than doubled compared to 1999 (see Table 1). The increase in the Czech Republic (150% from 1999 to 2001) was mostly caused by a rapid rise in applications lodged by nationals from Ukraine (+4,305), the Rep. of Moldova (+2,357), Romania (+1,715), Viet Nam (+1,487) and Georgia (+1,279). In Slovakia, the increase in applications (520% over two years) was primarily the result of the rise in applications submitted by Afghans (+3,672), Indians (+956) and Iraqis (+853). The three-year trend of Afghan asylum-seekers in these two countries is particularly noteworthy: a drop from 2,312 to 356 in the Czech Republic and an increase from 643 to 4,315 in Slovakia.

10. In Sweden, the increase in applications (110% in three years) is mostly explained by a rise in the number of claims lodged by Iraqis (+2,630), Bosnian (+2,288) and Yugoslav (+1,290) citizens. The increase in Bosnian applicants was partly caused by the arrival of rejected asylum-seekers from Germany following a decision in Sweden to allow Bosnians from minority areas to stay.

11. Six countries recorded a 50 to 100% increase in the number of asylum applications submitted during 1999-2001 (see Table 1). In Austria, the increase (+50%) was primarily caused by the high number of, mostly Afghan, asylum applications lodged at embassies and consulates abroad during 2001 (5,622), few of whom have been allowed to enter Austria. If these applications are excluded, the increase is limited to 34%. Although precise figures are not available, the number of applications lodged abroad before 2001 is believed to have been very small.

12. The increase in Bulgaria (+80%) is mostly explained by the rise in claimants from Afghanistan (from 277 in 1999 to 1,081 in 2001) and Iraq (from 197 to 720). In 2001, these two nationalities accounted for some 75% of all applications submitted in Bulgaria. In France, the increase from 1999 to 2001 (+53%) is mostly explained by the rise in applications lodged by citizens from Turkey (+3,132) and Haiti (+2,209).

13. Asylum applications in Poland increased by 58% from 1999 to 2001, mostly due to an increase in applicants from the Russian Federation (+1,409). Seven of the ten main nationalities applying for asylum in Poland during 1999-2001 are from successor states of the former USSR or from Central Europe (Table 10). In Slovenia, the number of asylum applicants from the Islamic Rep. of Iran, which had soared to almost 6,000 in 2000, fell to a more average level in 2001 (272). The 74% increase in the total number of applications from 1999 to 2001 was mostly caused by the rise in Turkish applicants (+321).

14. While the two-year increase in the United States (+94%) should be interpreted with some caution due to the unavailability of calendar year data for 1999, the rise in annual asylum applications in recent years registered by the Immigration and Naturalization Service is nevertheless evident. Nationalities showing the largest increase in applications submitted in the USA during 1999-2001 are Mexico (+7,497), Colombia (+7,302) and China (+4,640).

15. The five countries which recorded a decrease in asylum claims of some 50% or more during 1999-2001 were Finland, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg and Switzerland. In three countries (Liechtenstein, Luxembourg and Switzerland), the decline was linked to the exceptionally high level of claims lodged by citizens from the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (FRY) in 1999. In Finland, the number of


applications fell sharply after a peak in applications from citizens from Slovakia in 1999 and from Poland in 2000.

16. During 1999-2001, a number of asylum countries recorded relatively high arrivals of asylum-seekers from Central European countries such as Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland and Romania. In large part, these claims were lodged by Roma asylum-seekers.

17. Countries receiving the largest number of asylum-seekers during the three-year period from 1999 to 2001 compared to the size of their national population were Liechtenstein (19.9 applications per 1,000 inhabitants), Switzerland (11.8), Belgium (10.1), Luxembourg (9.6), Austria (8.5) and Norway (8.0). The 13 EU-countries for which complete data were available received 2.9 asylum-seekers for every 1,000 inhabitant during this period. The six Central European countries received 1.7 asylum-seeker for every 1,000 inhabitant, whereas for the non-European countries the figure was 1.0.

QUARTERLY AND MONTHLY TRENDS

18. Due to absence of data from Greece and the United Kingdom, the asylum trends during the fourth quarter of 2001 cannot yet be fully gauged. However, considering that 16 of the 26 asylum countries with complete quarterly data experienced a decrease, it is likely that the total number of applications fell significantly during this period. In the 12 EU countries for which quarterly data were available, 1.5% fewer applications were submitted during the fourth quarter than during the third (Table 2). In Central Europe, the number of claims lodged in October to December 2001 fell by 3.3%, whereas in the non-European countries the decline was even more pronounced (-14%).



19. From the second to the third quarter, both the 12 EU countries and Central Europe were still recording an increase in applications of some 15%, while the decline in the non-European countries had already started (-4%) (see Box 2).

20. In the 12 EU countries with complete data, the highest level in asylum applications submitted was in October. In Central Europe, the peak was reached in August, whereas the non-European countries recorded the highest number of monthly applications in June (Table 3).

ORIGIN OF ASYLUM APPLICANTS: ANNUAL TRENDS

21. In 2001, Afghan citizens lodged some 42,100 claims in the 26 industrialized countries with complete data, 60% more than in 2000 (26,300) (Table 4). As a result, Afghanistan became the largest country of origin of asylum-seekers in 2001, accounting for 8.6% of all asylum claims lodged. Iraq, recording a 13% increase from 2000 to 2001, remained the second largest country of origin. Turkey, which had ranked fourth in 2000 became the third largest country of origin in 2001 following an 11% increase in applications. During the entire three-year period, the largest number of asylum applications in the 26 industrialized countries was lodged by citizens from

FRY (13%), followed by Iraq (8%) and Afghanistan (6.5%). Due to the significant decrease in applications lodged by FRY citizens since 1999 (-76%), FRY dropped to the fourth largest country of origin in 2001 (Table 4).

22. Major asylum-seeker nationalities recording the highest relative increase in 2001 were Mexico (+100%), Colombia (+79%) and Indonesia (+69%). From 1999 to 2001, the relative increase in applications was the highest among citizens from Colombia (+421%), Mexico (+234%), Hungary (+163%) and Guinea (+152%) (Table 4). Some 85% of all Mexican asylum-seekers during 2001 lodged an application in the USA, whereas Colombians were mostly seeking asylum in the USA, Spain and Canada (see Table 8).

23. The 23 European countries with complete annual data reflect the same major trends as were outlined above for the 26 industrialized countries. Among the main nationalities, those recording the strongest relative increase from 2000 to 2001 included FYROM (525%), Ukraine (+83%) and Colombia (+75%) (Table 5).

24. Leading nationalities experiencing a strong decrease in annual asylum applications lodged in Europe in 2001 compared to 2000 include FRY (-36%), the Islamic Rep. of Iran (-55%), China (-32%), Pakistan (-25%), Slovakia (-38%) and Albania (-40%) (Table 5).

ORIGIN OF ASYLUM APPLICANTS: QUARTERLY AND MONTHLY TRENDS

25. During the fourth quarter of 2001, some 122,600 asylum applications had been submitted in 26 industrialized countries, 5% fewer than during the third quarter (Table 6). Nationalities recording the largest relative decrease in applications during this period were Bulgaria (-64%), FYROM (-48%), Romania (-47%) and Russian Federation (-26%). Countries of origin recording a relatively significant increase in quarterly claims included Cameroon (+38%), Zimbabwe (+36%) and the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) (+25%).

26. Since September 2001, the number of Afghan asylum applications has fallen significantly. In December 2001, 2,733 Afghan asylum applications were registered in the 26 countries for which data were available, 31% fewer than in September. In the same period, the total number of applications fell by only 16%. The monthly number of Iraqi asylum applications fell even more strongly (-36%) (see Box 3).


