- Preparations for GRF

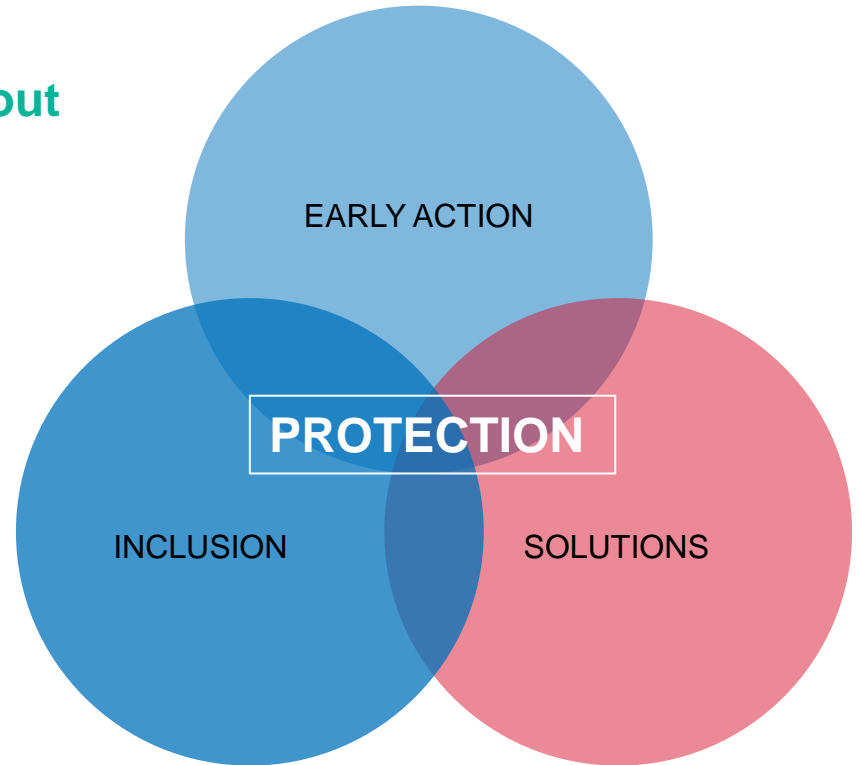
Outcomes

- Launch **concrete multi-stakeholder initiatives** to address specific challenges in a sustainable, coherent, and coordinated manner
- Inform **pledge cultivation and mobilization** related to development cooperation for the next Global Refugee Forum in 2023

THEMES

Protection crosscutting throughout

- 1. Early action:** Enhancing development cooperation to anticipate, respond to, and foster longer-term approaches to displacement
- 2. Inclusion:** Strengthening the role of development cooperation in facilitating inclusion in national systems
- 3. Solutions:** Unlocking solutions for the displaced through enhanced development cooperation

- Preparatory roundtables from September to November 2022 to explore the Dialogue themes in **specific displacement and stateless situations**.
- Serve as **case studies** stimulating reflection on learnings, challenges, and opportunities.
