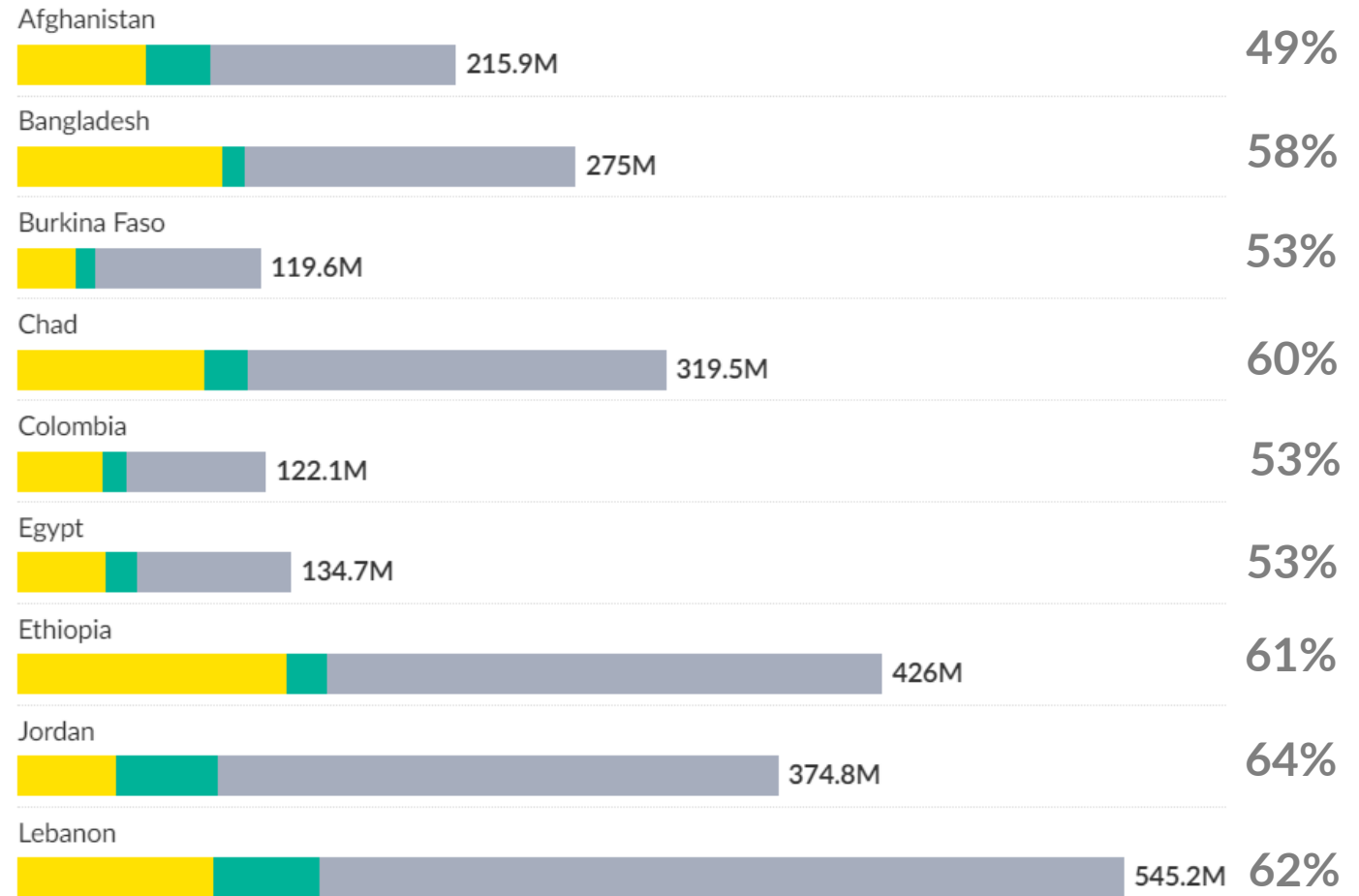

Top underfunded operations | 2024

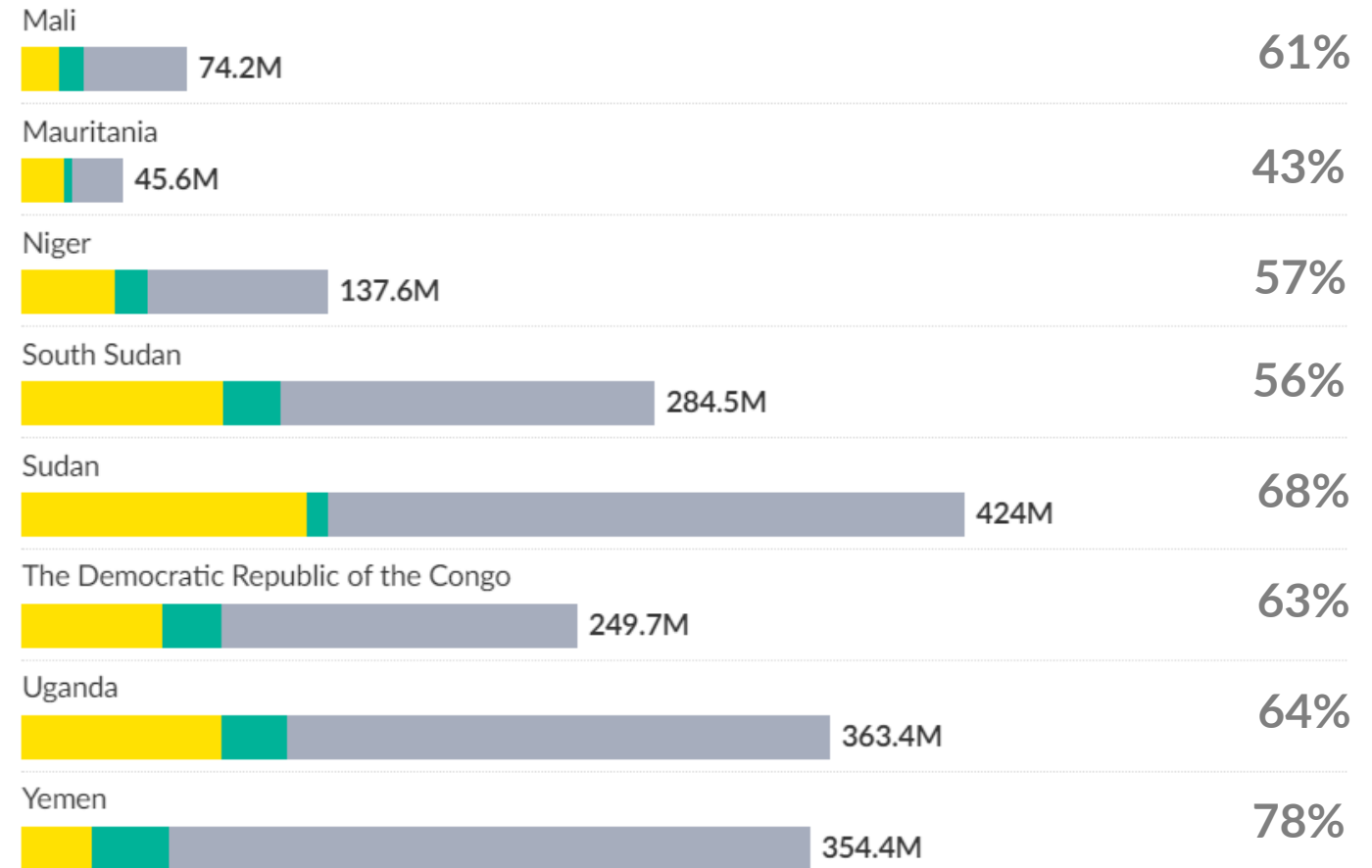
Earmarked Contributions Flexible Funding and Adjustments Funding Gap

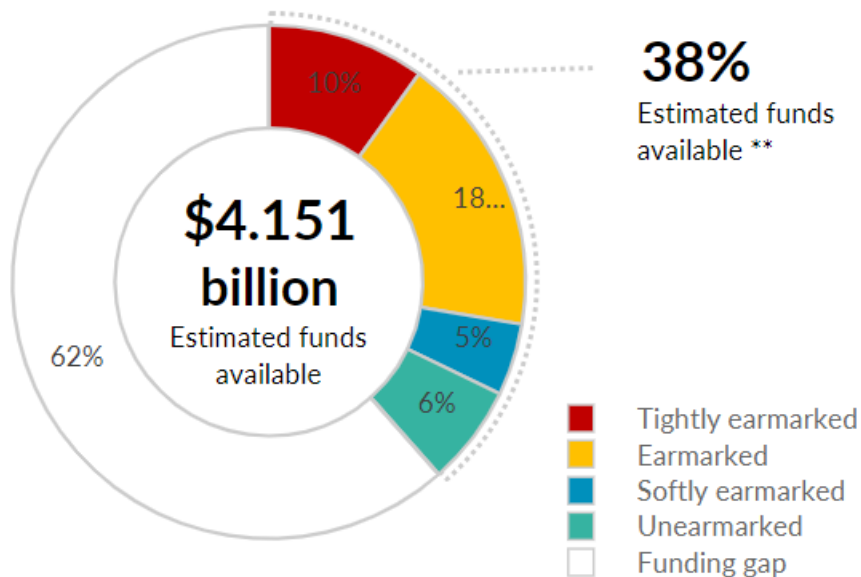
■ Earmarked Contributions ■ Flexible Funding and Adjustments ■ Funding Gap

\$6.634 billion

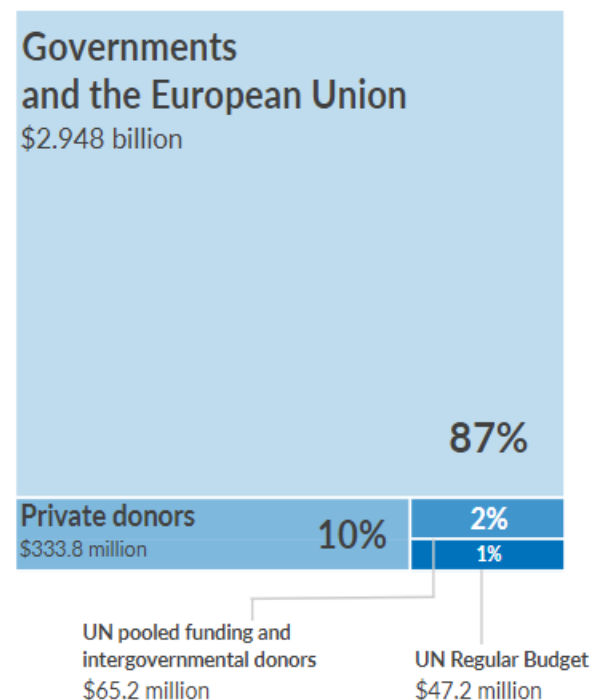

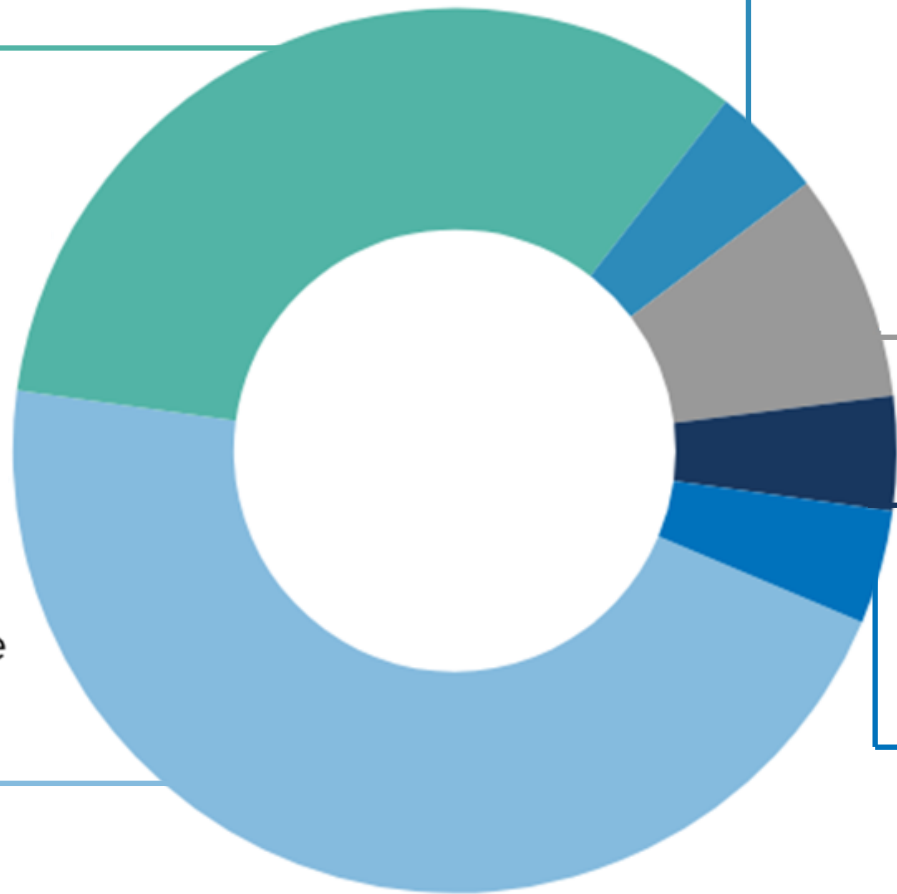
Climate financing: Emerging opportunities

Government Donors

- Eight Governments have contributed.
- 17 ongoing conversations.

Private Sector Donors

- 11 Private Sector partners have contributed.
- 35 ongoing conversations.



Multilateral Development Banks

- The Arab Bank for Economic Development in Africa contributed (\$500K for Zambia).
- Four ongoing conversations.

Partnerships

- Two partnerships.

Other (4)

- Two have contributed.
- Four ongoing conversations.

Vertical Climate Funds

- The Green Climate Fund (UNEP) contributed **new money** (\$6M for Tanzania).

Target 2024:

By the end of 2024, we are aiming to obtain **\$30M** in additional climate funding

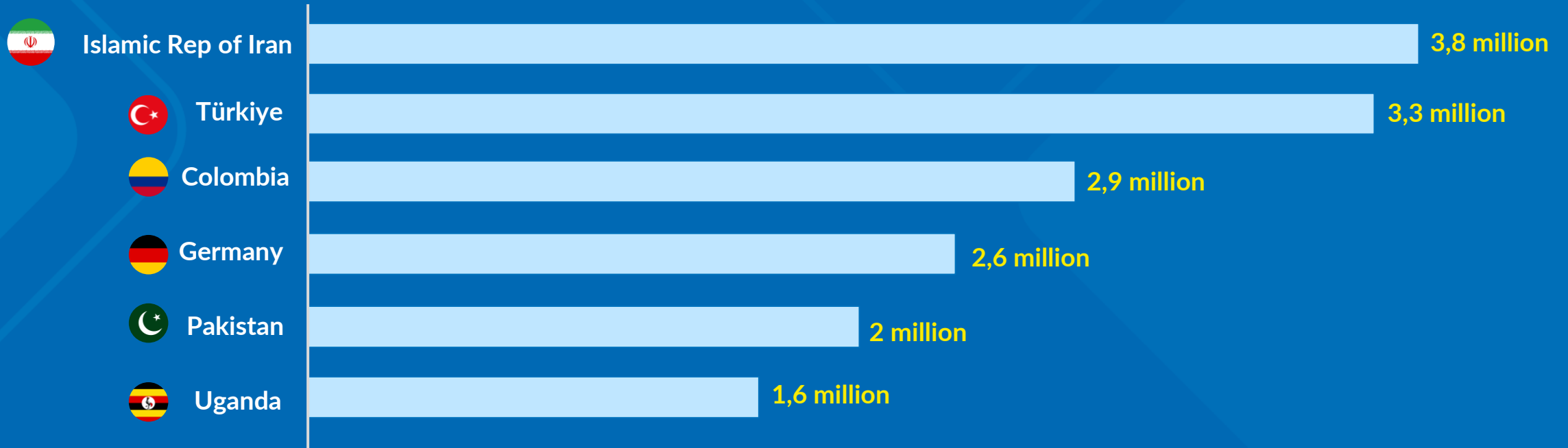
