



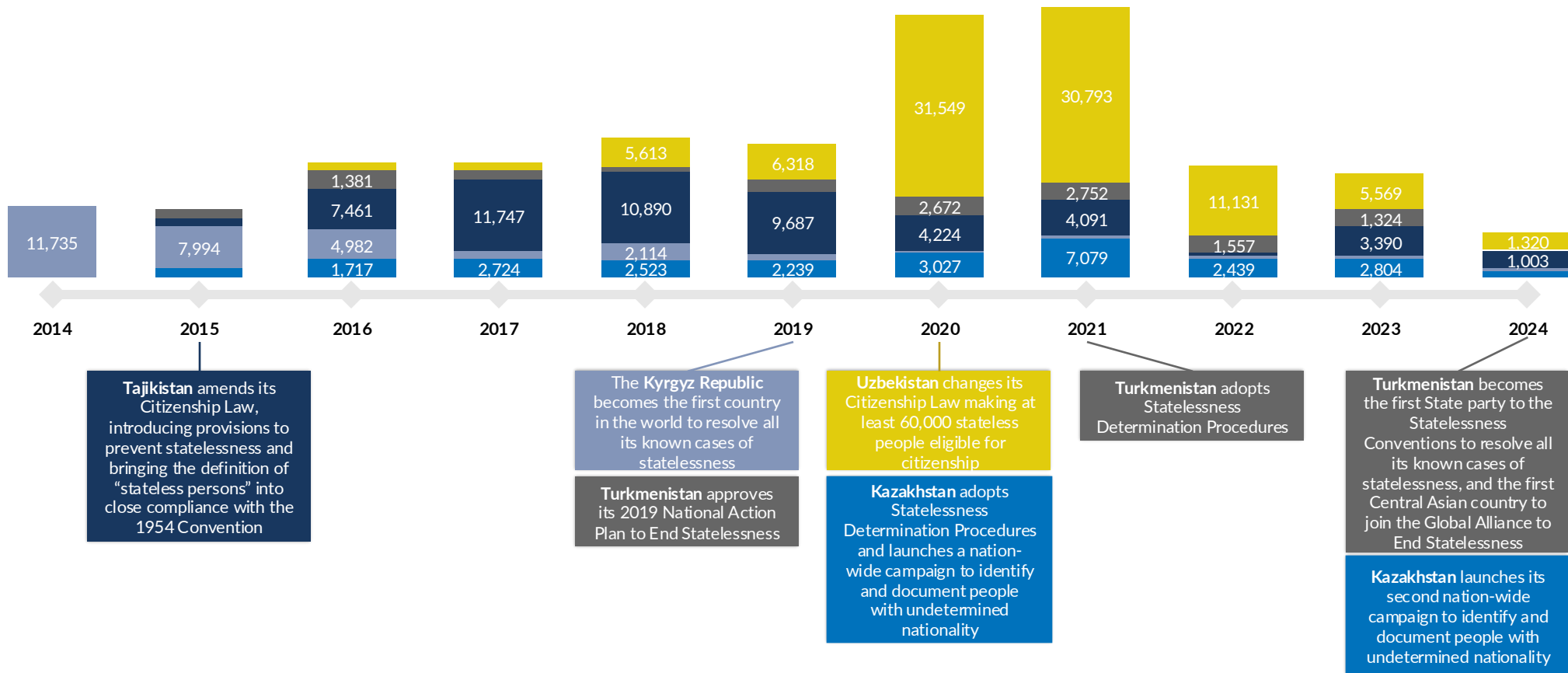
Launched in 2014, the global #IBelong Campaign aimed to end statelessness within ten years by identifying and protecting stateless people, resolving existing situations of statelessness, and preventing new cases from emerging. Through legal advocacy and awareness-raising, UNHCR worked with governments and partners around the globe to achieve the campaign goals. Central Asian States have significantly contributed to global efforts to end statelessness, focusing on establishing statelessness determination procedures and significantly reducing the number of stateless people, making the region a model for others. This graphic highlights some of Central Asia's achievements as of November 2024.
