The contract may be cancelled/revoked or suspended if:

- If the supplier commercial registration is suspended/ not renewed for any reason
- If the supplier is not compliant with the agreed menu items or agreed prices list. Or if the supplier introduced new items to the menu without UNHCR's prior approval for the item and the selling price.
- They have been convicted of an offence concerning their professional conduct by a court or they have been found guilty of professional misconduct proven by any means.
- They have been the subject of a judgment for fraud, corruption, involvement in any illegal activity detrimental to the Communities financial interests.
- The supplier is bankrupt or is having their affairs administered by the courts, have entered into an arrangement with creditors, have suspended business activities, or are the subject of proceedings concerning those matters
- If they have been declared to be in serious breach of contract for failure to comply with their contractual obligations.
- If they supplied false information/ misrepresentation requested by UNHCR contracting authority as a condition of participation in this tender or failed to supply this information. Or If they are subject to a conflict of interest
- If the catering supplier subcontracted the catering service with other suppliers. Subcontract means the awarded contractor's assigning, leasing, making out work to, or employing, another person to support such primary contractor in the execution of part of a project in terms of the contract.
- If the supplier violated any of the terms and conditions agreed herein or any of the terms of reference clauses.
