

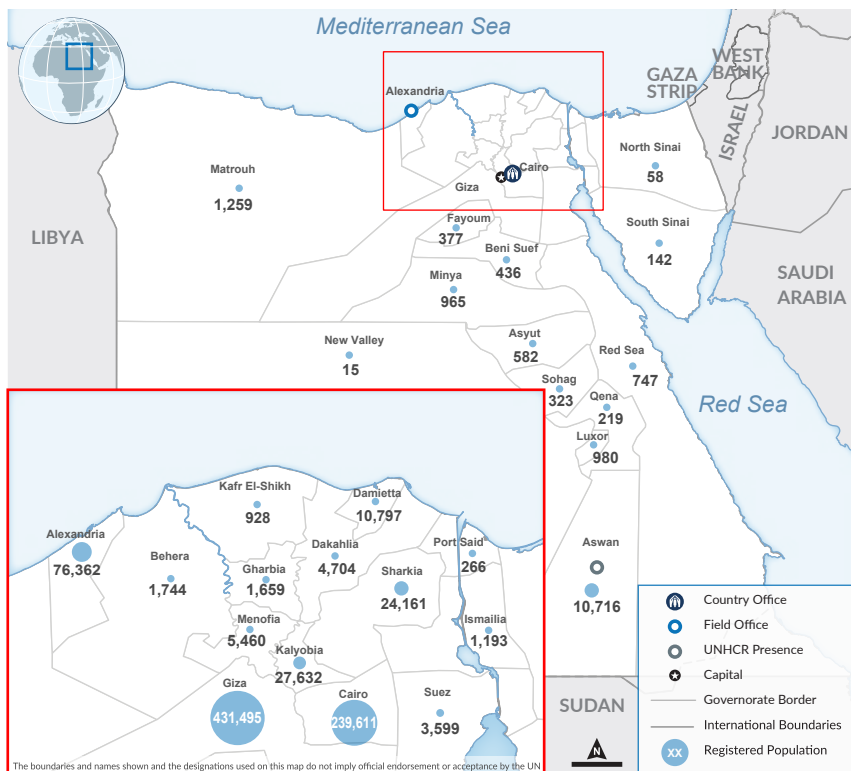
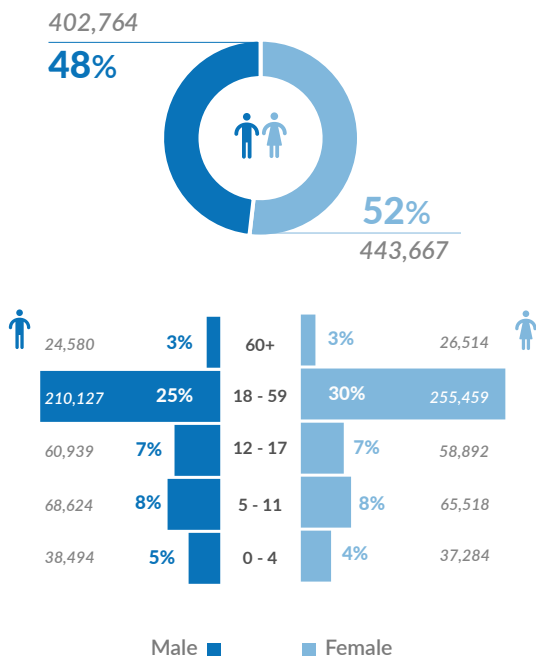

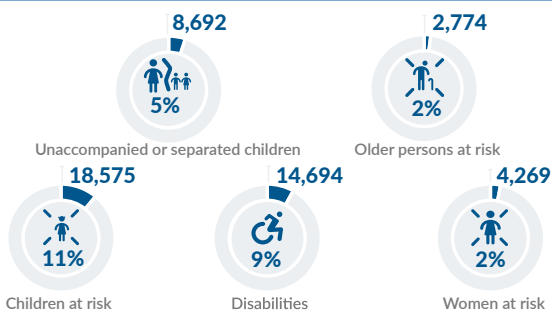

Percentage growth in Sudanese refugee numbers versus all nationalities between 31 March 2023 (pre Sudan crisis) and 30 November 2024.

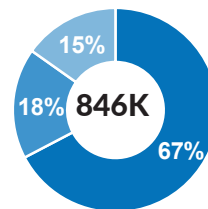

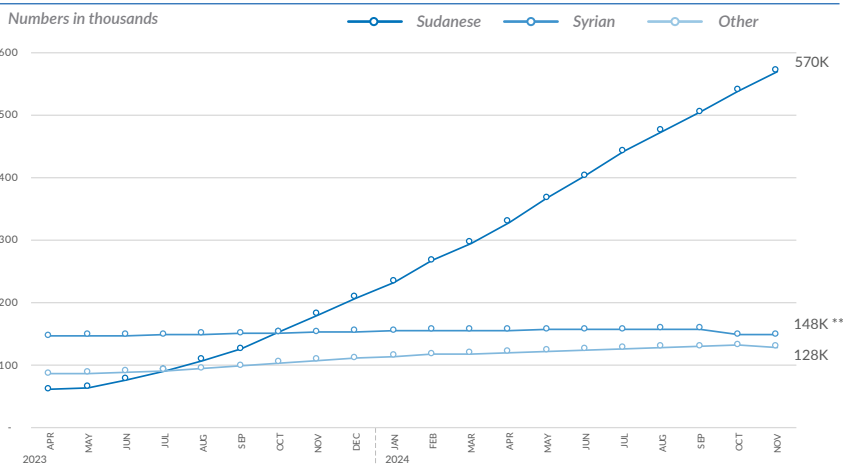
