CASE ANALYSIS

An analysis of approximately 300 words for each of the cases presented below while taking under consideration the legal framework applicable to UNHCR in Greece is requested.

Case A

UNHCR Greece is about to recruit a new employee under a UNOPS contract for two years. The new employee will be member of UNHCR's affiliate workforce (AWF) (not a UNHCR staff member). The individual concerned is a third country national who requires a visa in order to enter Greece. The individual is a national of Egypt, female, single, born in Cairo in 1990.

How will the new recruit's stay in Greece be regularized? In specific,

- 1. what documents should she possess in order to reside legally in the country?
- 2. what documents should she possess to be legally employed by UNHCR?

Reference is to be made to the applicable laws as part of the analysis.

Case B

UNHCR Greece published in its website an invitation to suppliers to provide quotations for the purchase of smoke detectors for installation at the Closed Controlled Access Centre (CCAC)/Reception and Identification Centre (RIC) on island Q. The smoke detectors are being installed at the request of the Managing Authority. The supplier who provided the most cost-effective offer and received the award is based in Germany. The invoice will be issued to UNHCR Greece (Greek tax details), noting that UNHCR Greece has no VIES registration.

- 1. Will the invoice be issued with or without VAT?
- 2. Is the invoice eligible for VAT exemption?
- 3. If so, what is the process to be followed?

Reference is to be made to the applicable VAT exemption framework as part of the analysis.
