
Indonesia Monthly Statistical Report November 2024




Total Population: 12,083 Individuals (6,703 Cases)

The total number of persons registered with UNHCR in Indonesia includes 8,068 refugees and 4,015 asylumseekers, all of whom are defined as refugees under Indonesian law. UNHCR continues to register the 513 individuals who disembarked between October and November. Updates will be reflected in the next statistical report.

Population based on Age and Gender




*Between 0-17 years old ** Above 60 years old





Children Registered with UNHCR










At the end of November, there are 3,654 children registered with UNHCR, including 3,399 children in Indonesia with a parent or traditional caretaker, 139 children who are unaccompanied by a parent or other adult relative, and 116 children who are separated from their parents but living with an adult caregiver. Together with our partners, UNHCR is working to ensure all refugee children have access to an education, and as of November some 760 refugee children are enrolled in accredited national schools.

Rohingya Boat Arrivals



Rohingya refugees have undertaken perilous sea journeys from Myanmar and Bangladesh seeking safety, family reunification, and access to livelihoods and education for years. Since 2023, 3,075 Rohingya refugees (the majority of whom are women and children) have landed in Aceh and North Sumatra, Indonesia. While the number of arrivals remains small, more Rohingya have arrived by boat to Indonesia in 2023 and 2024 than arrived in the previous eight years combined. The sea journey remains a dangerous one, with over 1,000 Rohingya deaths at sea in 2022 and 2023.
