
Indonesia Monthly Statistical Report October 2024




Total Population: 11,874 Individuals (6,604 Cases)

The total number of persons registered with UNHCR in Indonesia includes 8,090 refugees and 3,784 asylum-seekers, all of whom are defined as refugees under Indonesian law. UNHCR continues to register the 395 individuals who disembarked from boats in Indonesia in the last week of October. Updates will be reflected in the next statistical report.

Population based on Age and Gender




*Between 0-17 years old ** Above 60 years old





Children Registered with UNHCR










At the end of October, there are 3,535 children registered with UNHCR, including 3,302 children in Indonesia with a parent or traditional caretaker, 129 children who are unaccompanied by a parent or other adult relative, and 104 children who are separated from their parents but living with an adult caregiver. Together with our partners, UNHCR is working to ensure all refugee children have access to an education, and as of October some 769 refugee children are enrolled in accredited national schools.

Rohingya Boat Arrivals



Rohingya refugees have undertaken perilous sea journeys from Myanmar and Bangladesh seeking safety, family reunification, and access to livelihoods and education for years. Since 2023, 2,957 Rohingya refugees (the majority of whom are women and children) have landed in Aceh and North Sumatra, Indonesia. While the number of arrivals remains small, more Rohingya have arrived by boat to Indonesia in 2023 and 2024 than arrived in the previous eight years combined. The sea journey remains a dangerous one, with over 1,000 Rohingya deaths at sea in 2022 and 2023.
