

We at Great Step Initiative (GSI) a Refugee Led Organisation, in order to assist ourselves and the host communities, we are engaged in Psycho-social support across the both communities for effective use of the opportunities at our disposal by UNHCR and her Partners.

With the great success registered in the sensitization, we are engaged in a series of activities which in hardship pledge one and two, thus reducing pressure on the host country and enhance refugee self reliance

1. We trained POCs on Cassava procession into more income generator of durable products.
2. We also trained some of them on cosmetology and they can produce a chain of items like detergents, Vaseline, liquid and tablet soap, sanitizers.
3. 30 women are trained in tailoring and this assisted us in the production of face mask and reusable sanitary pads at a time when access to basic services are restricted.
4. 10 youths have just gone through digital marketing in other not to be excluded in the now digital economy which has taken the global stage.
5. In our pursuit of the GCR, we are currently running a football tournament among the 24 under 14 girls and boys clubs we created. This is a major unifying tool between the refugees and the host communities apart from the rights of a step towards self reliance, integration and peaceful coexistence.

We are carrying out activities in Cross River and Taraba states Nigeria. All thanks to the funds UNHCR gave us through the innovation award 2020 for our role in the covid-19 Pandemic response.
