14. During the planning process for the 2006 ORB, DIST referred to ICT industry benchmarks to determine the costs of new strategic initiatives due to start in 2006. The resultant 2006 budget approved by the ORB which reflected these strategic initiatives amounted to \$41.9 million. Sixty-five per cent of the approved 2006 budget (\$27.3 million) represents strategic activities associated with the completion of the MSRP Finance and Supply Chain roll-out and the development and deployment of MSRP Human Resources and Payroll. Five per cent (\$2.1 million) represents new strategic initiatives not directly related to MSRP. The remaining 30 per cent of the budget (\$12.5 million) represents commitments to service delivery already under way and fixed administrative costs (such as software licenses).
