Introduction

This brief report provides an overview of refugee trends in 95 countries for which UNHCR country offices had reported statistics to UNHCR Headquarters by end-September 2006. The 95 countries included are mostly developing countries where UNHCR has operations. The main purpose of this report is to provide updated statistics for individual countries and operations.² Trends in the number of refugee status applications and decisions are analyzed separately in the document Trends in Refugee Status Determination, 1 January - 30 June 2006. The statistics presented here should be considered as provisional, subject to change.

Changes in the Refugee Population

- This section summarizes the main changes in the size of the refugee population from the beginning of the year 2006 to 30 June 2006. The main causes of these changes (new arrivals, durable solutions, registration) are provided in the following two sections.
- In the 95 asylum countries considered here, the total refugee population remained stable at around 6.2 million. During the first half of 2006, the refugee population in these 95 countries combined increased by less than one per cent (+0.3%) or 16,000 persons. During the same period, the refugee population directly assisted by or through UNHCR remained at around 4.4 million, a marginal decrease of less than one per cent (-0.7%) (see Table 1).
- Among the 48 countries hosting more than 5,000 refugees as of 30 June 2006, eleven recorded an increase in the refugee population of five per cent or more. The highest increase was reported by Uganda where the refugee population increased from 257,300 to 332,500 (+75,000). This increase is primarily the result of newly included estimates of Sudanese refugees in the Arua district (20,000) and an estimated 50,000 refugees from the Dem. Rep. of the Congo living in the border area. The refugee population in the Dem. Rep. of the Congo increased from 204,300 to 233,000 (+14%) as a result of a registration exercise conducted among spontaneously settled Angolan refugees in the provinces of Bas Congo and Kinshasa. Due to ongoing conflict in the Darfur region of Sudan and the volatile situation in the Central African Republic, the refugee population in Chad increased from 286.000 at the beginning of the year to 306,800 as of 31 March 2006³. This increase can be attributed to newly arriving refugees from Sudan (12,000) and the Central African Republic (6,900). Other major refugee-hosting countries experiencing an increase in their refugee population include Thailand (+12,200), Kenya (+8,100), Yemen (+6,100), and Malaysia (4,400).
- Nine countries hosting more than 5,000 refugees recorded a decrease in the refugee population of at least five per cent. In Cameroon, the refugee figure fell from 52,000 to 18,700 (-64%) as a result of de-registration of some 32,300 Chadian and 2,200 Nigerian refugees. In Sierra Leone, 36 per cent fewer refugees were reported at 30 June 2006 as compared to the beginning of the year due to voluntary repatriation of some 21,600 refugees to Liberia. In Serbia and Montenegro⁴, the refugee figure fell by 23 per cent (from 148,300 to 114,500) due to loss of refugee status of some 32,300 Croatian and Bosnian refugees following a registration exercise conducted in the country in 2004-2005.

NEW ARRIVALS

- 6. Among the 95 asylum countries included here, *new arrivals* involving more than 1,000 refugees were reported by 14 countries, including Chad (19,200), Thailand (10,600), Kenya (10,400), Yemen (5,700), Malaysia (5,100), Uganda (4,400), and India (4,100) (see *Table 1*).
- 7. These outflows concerned mostly Sudanese refugees (12,300) and refugees from the Central African Rep. (6,900) fleeing to Chad⁵ as well as Sudanese refugees fleeing to the Dem. Rep. of the Congo (1,800) and Kenya (3,800). Other major new arrivals were reported for refugees from Myanmar in Malaysia (4,400) and Thailand (10,300). Other countries of origin reporting outflows were recorded for Somalis fleeing to Kenya (6,200) and Yemen (5,700), Sri Lankan refugees arriving in India (3,800) as well as Iraqis arriving in the Syrian Arab Republic⁶ (3,600) (see Tables 2 and 3).

DURABLE SOLUTIONS

- 8. **Voluntary repatriation** departures involving more than 1,000 refugees⁷ were reported by the UNHCR country offices located in Pakistan (31,000), Sierra Leone (21,600), the United Rep. of Tanzania (15,300), the Dem. Rep. of the Congo (14,500), Guinea (8,500)⁸, Congo (6,900), and Uganda (3,500) (see Tables 1 and 4). The 95 countries included in this overview reported the departure of some 113,400 refugees, of whom some 89,200 were facilitated by UNHCR.
- 9. UNHCR offices in the 95 asylum countries included in this report resettled some 8,500 refugees during the first half year of 2006. Fourteen offices facilitated more than 100 departures. Most *resettlement departures* facilitated by UNHCR took place from Kenya (2,300), Egypt (1,350), Thailand (1,100), Turkey (1,000), Malaysia (540), the United Rep. of Tanzania (370), Uganda (320), and Ethiopia (320)⁹ (see Table 1).
- 10. Within these 95 first asylum countries, the nationalities benefiting mostly from resettlement facilitated by UNHCR included refugees from Somalia (2,100), Sudan (1,600), Myanmar (1,600), the Islamic Rep. of Iran (1,000), Afghanistan (550), Ethiopia (480)⁹, the Dem. Rep. of the Congo (470), Burundi (270), Colombia (230), and Liberia (190).
