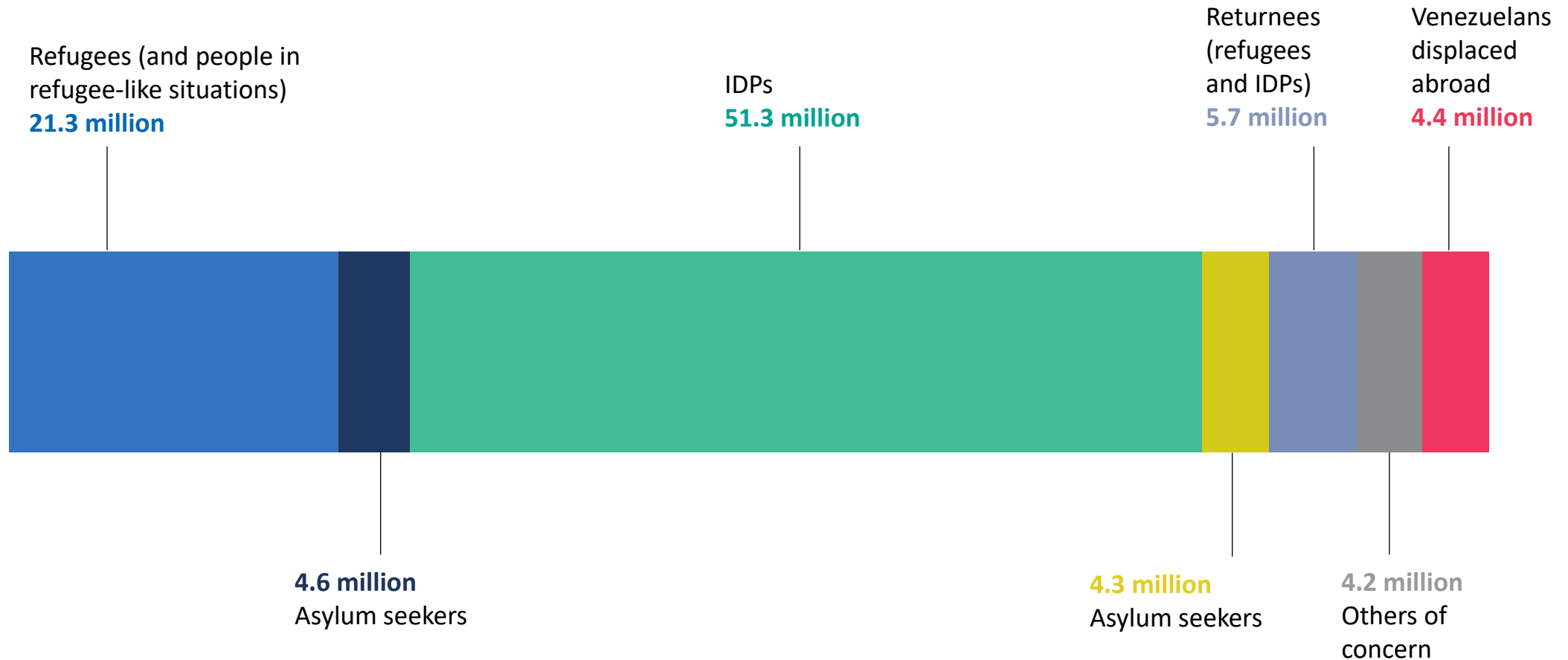

COVID-19



19.7 million people in **148 countries** accessed protection services.



162 countries included people of concern in their national COVID-19 response.



3.3 million forcibly displaced people in 66 countries received at least one dose of vaccine.



9.29 million people received essential health care services.



26 new laws or legislative changes in 2021, of which **17** advanced refugees' rights.



63,190 **refugee cases** submitted for resettlement to **23** **countries**.



81,200 **stateless individuals** acquired a nationality or had it confirmed.



21.7 million individual records in UNHCR's PRIMES registration system, **45% more** than 2020.



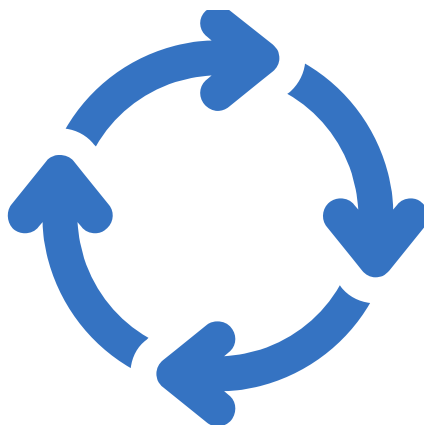
1.9 million children enrolled in primary school. Primary enrolment was improved or maintained in **49 out of 95 refugee situations**.



\$668 million distributed in cash assistance to **9.3 million people** in over 100 countries.



\$47.6 million worth of core relief items dispatched, serving **132 requests**.



Effective coordination and **leadership** are established for UNHCR-led clusters at the global and operational levels.



\$1.4 billion went to **1,151 partners**, including **727 national NGOs**, **25% of global expenditure**.

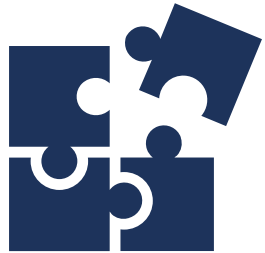


Global Compact on Refugees



- **200** additional pledges submitted.
- **1,600** total number of pledges made.
- **75%** of pledges reported as in progress.
- **160** pledges fulfilled.

Donor Support



Funding gap grew from 41% to 44% of needs.

\$625.3 million from the private sector:



- \$377.2 million from individual donors.
- \$248.1 million from companies, foundations and philanthropists.
