

## Notice on the wearing of masks in public

With effect from **Saturday**, **11 December 2021**:

## **Masks** must now be worn in **all indoor and outdoor public spaces**.

These include offices, shops, cultural and entertainment venues and all open-air spaces. Masks must also be worn when one is **walking alone** in both urban and countryside areas. Masks need not be worn when one is **seated** at a bar or restaurant.

## Notice on COVID-19 vaccine booster dose

The Maltese Health Authorities have decided to offer the booster dose to all persons over 12 years. The booster dose should be given after 6 months have passed from the second dose of any Covid-19 vaccine (or from the single dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine).

Registration for the booster dose is currently open for anyone who is fully vaccinated and is aged 35 and over. Registration for the booster (for individuals with a Maltese residence card) is online on <a href="https://vaccin.gov.mt/">https://vaccin.gov.mt/</a>.
