

## **Updated COVID-19 Measures**

## With effect from 21 February 2022:

 Quarantine period for fully vaccinated primary contacts (who are not part of the same household) will be reduced to 5 days; if followed by a negative test result on the 5th day of quarantine.

## With effect from 7 March 2022:

- Quarantine for people testing positive for COVID-19 who have a valid vaccine certificate will be reduced to 7 days, if followed by a negative test on the 7th day of quarantine.
- No quarantine needed for fully vaccinated primary contacts.
- **Fully vaccinated school children** can go back to school after five days of quarantine.
- Children who have two doses and are **primary contact will not need to quarantine**.

## With effect from 14 March 2022:

- No masks in public places.
- Masks will only be mandatory **inside** and when attending **mass events**.
