
1-31 March 2020

3,292 refugees of different nationalities arrived at the ETC since its establishment in September 2008.

49 refugees originating from **Eritrea**, **Sudan and Syria**, evacuated from **Libya** were assisted in March.

Due to the state of emergency of the **COVID-19** outbreak, all departures from and to Romania were suspended and all arrivals/departures were not possible in March.


Countries of Origin



Countries of First Asylum




Vacancy and Occupancy as of 31 March




*The maximum capacity of the ETC is 200. However, the actual capacity does not coincide the number of vacant places 89, due to special room arrangements for people with specific needs.
