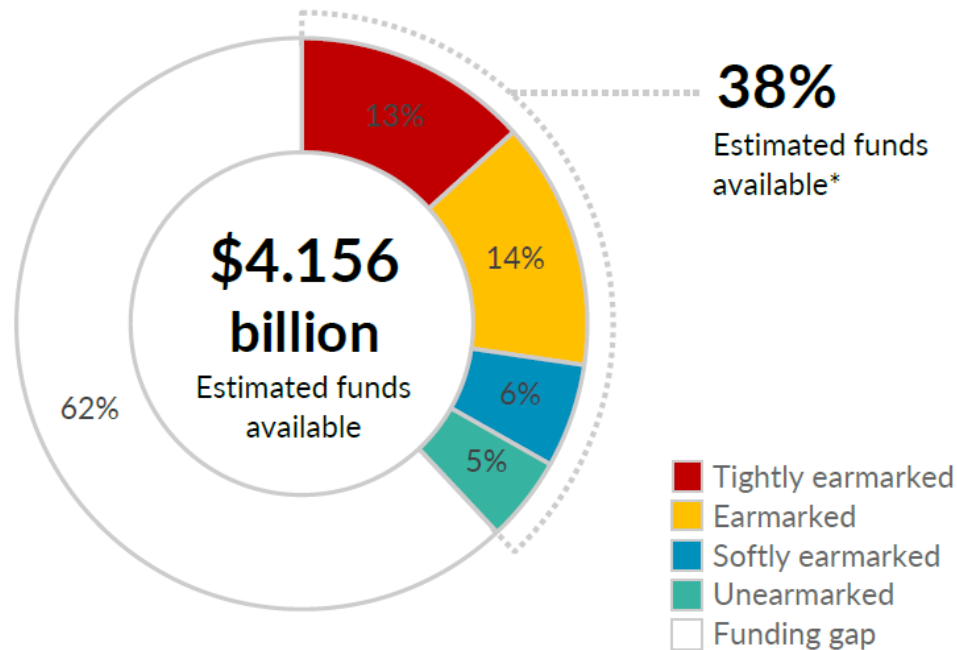

Current budget



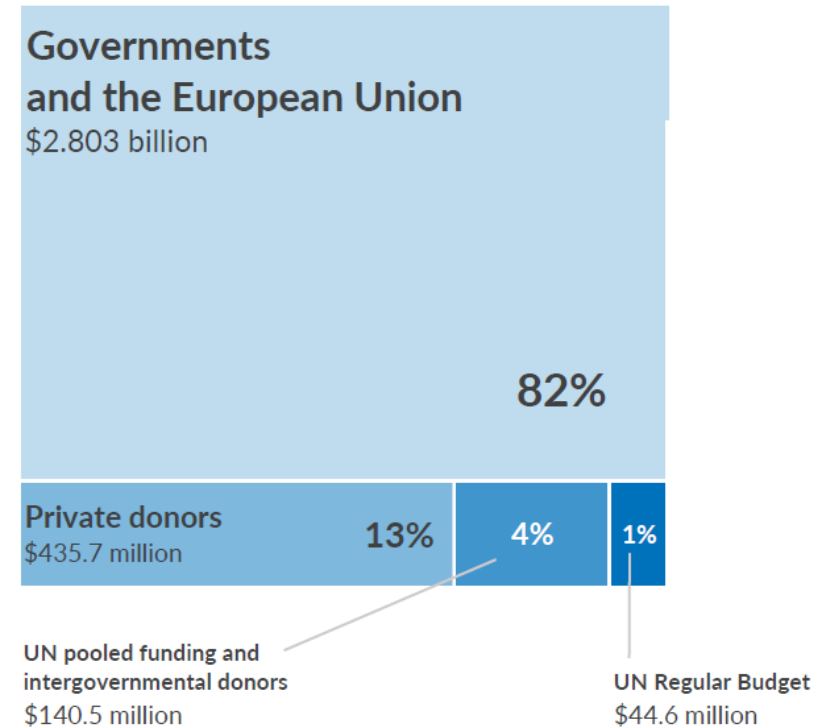

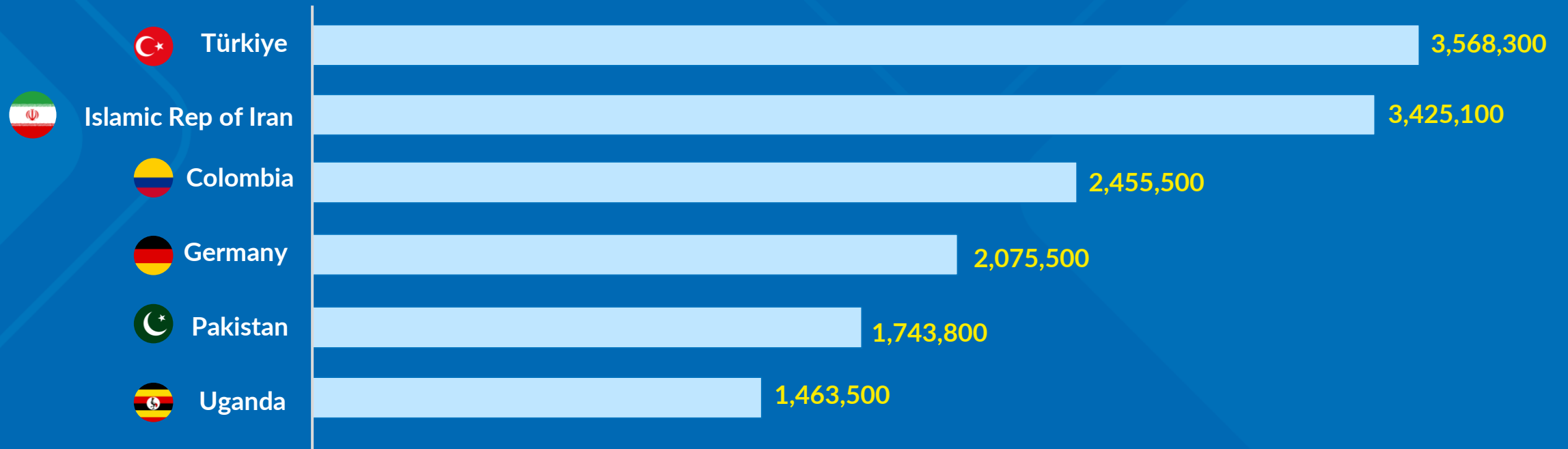
