REPORT ON THE WORK OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE

I. INTRODUCTION

1. At its forty-seventh session in October 1996, the Executive Committee adopted a decision on the programme of work of the Standing Committee in 1997 (A/AC.96/878, para. 27) in which it set out the issues to be examined by the Standing Committee.

2. In accordance with Executive Committee Working Methods adopted at the forty-sixth session (A/AC.96/860, para. 32), the Standing Committee held four meetings in the course of 1997: in January, April/May, June and September/October 1997. A planning meeting of Executive Committee members in December 1996 established the calendar of meetings and determined the distribution of the different agenda items (see Annex I).

3. A detailed account of the work undertaken at each of the meetings of the Standing Committee is contained in the following reports: A/AC.96/879: *Report of the Fifth Meeting of the Standing Committee (11 December 1996)*; A/AC.96/880: *Report of the Sixth Meeting of the Standing Committee (30-31 January 1997)*; A/AC.96/881: *Report of the Seventh Meeting of the Standing Committee (30 April-1 May 1997)*; A/AC.96/888: *Report of the Eighth Meeting of the Standing Committee (24-26 June 1997)*; A/AC.96/894: *Report of the Ninth Meeting of the Standing Committee (9-10 September and 8 October 1997)*.

Issues covered by the Standing Committee in 1997

4. The work undertaken by the Standing Committee included a number of recurrent items. As foreseen in the Decision on Budget Structure and Governance (A/AC.96/860, para. 22(1)), in-depth reviews of UNHCR programmes

and activities in different regions were conducted at each of the meetings, allowing the Standing Committee to oversee more effectively the evolution of General and Special Programmes in the areas concerned. Central Asia, South West Asia, North Africa and the Middle East were reviewed in January; Europe and former Yugoslavia in April/May; Africa in June; and the Americas, and Asia and the Pacific in September.

5. In addition, the Standing Committee considered at each of its meetings regular updates on overall programme and funding issues, through which it kept abreast of the situation in terms of General and Special Programme budgets, funding, and allocations made from the various criteria funds (programme reserve, emergency fund and voluntary repatriation fund).

6. At its various meetings, the Standing Committee also reviewed programme policy issues. In January it examined the impact of refugees on the environment, and the economic and social impact of large refugee populations on host developing countries. In April/May, it reviewed UNHCR's efforts in respect to refugee children, including UNHCR's strategy for follow-up to the report on the impact of armed conflict on children, and in September it looked at developments within UNHCR in respect to refugee women, refugee health and nutrition, and the newly reissued Resettlement Handbook.

7. In accordance with Executive Committee Working Methods (A/AC.96/865, para. 32(d)), the June meeting of the Standing Committee focused particularly on questions of international protection. Two days were devoted to consideration of the Note on International Protection (A/AC.96/882), which focused on the institution of asylum and a number of other issues stemming from the conclusions on international protection adopted at the forty-seventh session, including admission, *non-refoulement*, the civilian nature of refugee camps and the physical security of refugees and others of concern. It also examined how asylum responds to contemporary protection needs and how it can be strengthened. In addition, issues relating to statelessness, the application of the exclusion and cessation clauses, and the return of persons not in need of international protection were reviewed, as were progress reports on informal consultations on international protection for all who need it and activities for refugee law promotion, dissemination and training were reviewed. Conclusions resulting from the Standing Committee's consideration of these protection issues are being submitted to the forty-eighth session for adoption.

8. Several coordination issues, including further follow-up to ECOSOC resolution 1995/56 on the strengthening of emergency humanitarian assistance of the United Nations, were considered during the year. In addition, in September, updates on the use of memoranda of understanding as mechanisms of coordination and on the Partnership in Action (PARinAC) process, whereby UNHCR endeavours to strengthen its relations with NGOs, were reviewed.

9. In terms of issues of oversight identified by the Executive Committee, in January the Standing Committee examined UNHCR's internal audit function, in April/May it looked at information systems and programming issues, and in September it reviewed issues relating to implementing partners, including audit certification, training and performance evaluation. The Standing Committee also examined other issues of evaluation; notably, it considered an evaluation of UNHCR's response to the Rwanda emergency in June and in September it looked at staff stress and security, as well as the

implementation of policy and guidelines on refugee children. Planned evaluation activities in 1997 were also reviewed by the Standing Committee in January.

10. The question of enhanced NGO observer participation in the Standing Committee was also addressed. Following a series of informal consultations chaired by the Vice-Chairman of the Executive Committee, the Standing Committee adopted a decision in June establishing criteria for enhanced NGO participation. In line with Executive Committee working methods, the Standing Committee also undertook the selection of the annual theme for the forty-eighth session of the Executive Committee during its two sessions in April/May and June, adopting the theme of "repatriation challenges".

11. With regard to management and administrative matters, the Standing Committee was kept regularly apprised, by means of written and oral reports, of progress made in UNHCR's change management process, Project Delphi.

12. The Standing Committee also undertook a preliminary review, in the light of the Report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (ACABQ) (A/AC.96/884/Add.3), of the budgetary and financial documentation being presented to the forty-eighth session of the Executive Committee.
