DIST	Under implementation	The ICT network has set up a task force to look at common procurement. UNHCR is participating in common procurement agreements set up by the ICT Network. While no joint procurement of software has been conducted so far, UNHCR has initiated an agreement with Microsoft, Novell and Adobe resulting in better prices for the UN family for software products as well as for support and maintenance. For telecoms, no joint procurement has taken place. DIST update as at October 06
