These questions can be used to set up a debate in class. You can choose a "for" group and an "against" group.

The questions can also be used for students to discuss and research findings in groups and write essays on their opinions and research.

Debate question 1:

Stateless people do not have the nationality of any country.

How can you tell if someone is stateless? What do you think defines citizenship?

Debate question 2: Stateless people often have less opportunity in life than people who do have a nationality.

What should countries do to improve the situation of stateless people?

Debate question 3: Statelessness is complex and can have several causes.

Can you imagine situations could cause statelessness in your country?
