
Proposed revised UNHCR financial rules EC/73/SC/CRP.21

Timeline (updated)

UNHCR financial regulations & rules





Effective



ACABQ Observations (Report A/76/729)

- 1. Operational Urgency not clear from ExCom Decision
- 2. Approval Authority Approval and adoption of any revised regulations is under the sole purview of the Assembly
- 3. Proliferation of more requests
- 4. Inconsistencies from multiple regulations impacting SG reform

CONCLUSION: Committee recommends against proposal made by UNHCR ExCom to grant UNHCR the authority to develop its own financial regulations.



5th Committee Consideration

Extract from draft resolution:

7.alt.6 Recalls paragraph 11 of the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, acknowledges the need for a separate set of financial rules and regulations of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees in order for it to be fit for purpose when responding to the specific needs and operational requirements of this office;

Conclusions

- Supported the need for UNHCR to have separate set of financial rules and regulations fit for purpose
- Overcame ACABQ concerns (report A/76/729) who recommended against proposal to grant UNHCR the authority to develop its own financial regulations



5th Committee Consideration

Extract from draft resolution:

7.alt.6.bis Recognizes merit in the request of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner to establish its own set of financial regulations, which are specifically applicable to the organization and assents to the submission of a comprehensive set of draft rules and regulations for the consideration of the General Assembly at its seventy-seventh session.

Conclusions

- No agreement reached on FRR approval process proposal to submit financial rules and regulations for consideration of GA [while ExCom already has delegation to approve rules since 1957, no other UN agency submits FRR to GA]
- <u>Conclusion</u>: after extensive deliberations decision was to take "no action" on the ExCom request to the GA to grant UNHCR its own financial regulations



Next steps – Options Presented June 2022

- No action.
 UNHCR continues to operate with UN Regulations and UNHCR Rules
- Explore further 5th Committee options for coming year. Establishing Advisory Group of Member States to guide whether resubmission to 5th Committee feasible.
 - Change UNHCR financial rules.

 Build off of draft regulations and see how we can capture majority of improvements through adjustments to rules only to develop an improved UN Regulations and UNHCR Rules in a new document.

Subject Follow-up on the side-event on UNHCR's financial regulations and rules

On behalf of Mr. Hans Baritt, Controller and Director of the Division of Financial and Administrative Management (DFAM), I would like to thank you all for your participation and the interest that you have shown during yesterday's side event on UNHCR Financial Regulations and Rules. The event was an opportunity to update you on the process to seek the General Assembly's approval to grant UNHCR the authority to develop its own financial regulations. As highlighted yesterday, the Fifth Committee unfortunately took "no action" on this request earlier this year, leaving UNHCR with the option to either re-submit the request or to work to improve the UNHCR financial rules only (i.e. no change to the UN Financial Regulations). Attached please find a copy of the Controller's presentation.

UNHCR would like to thank you once again for all the support extended to the organization throughout the process of transforming its financial framework. This is one of many important efforts we are undertaking to find the most efficient and effective means to meet the needs of the people we serve.



Option 2 – Details

- Process: Establish an Advisory Group of Member States from different regional groupings.
- Task: Work together to determine likelihood of success in resubmitting the request to the General Assembly to reconsider the decision to take "no action" on the ExCom request to the GA to grant UNHCR its own financial regulations
- Outcome: Provide guidance to UNHCR to present way forward at September 2022 Standing Committee (resubmit or work to improve rules).



Option 3 – Financial Rules V


Process: Propose to improve UNHCR Financial Rules only and try to capture any UNHCR specifications.

- Present draft* at September 2022 Standing Committee.
- Revising and presenting UNHCR financial rules in conjunction with corresponding UN Financial Regulations with the aim to:
 - capture in the rules those aspects specific to UNHCR in the application of UN Regs, and
 - flag UN Regs which are not applicable to UNHCR.
- Propose to ExCom to endorse for 1 January 2023.

Main changes

Budgeting Process

New rules on **budgeting process** to clarify aspects related to the budget preparation and submission which are specific to UNHCR's governance structure

New rules on **UN regular budget** to reflect the process for the regular budget allotment received by UNHCR from the UN

UN regular budget

Internal Control Revising the internal control provisions with describing the overall concepts and key principles; considering UN Regs and Rules



Main changes (continued)

Write-Off Simplified rule on write-off to remove delegation of authority's details to approve write-off as details are covered in internal instructions (no need to be rules)

New rules on available period of appropriations for commitments in line with UN

Commitment period



Main changes (continued)

Asset Management New rules on asset management reflecting former UNHCR rules with updated language of UN Rules and UNHCR processes

Simplified language on implementation of programmes as details are covered in internal instructions (Rule 509.2-509.5)

Programme Implementation

Ex-gratia Payments Raising threshold of authority delegated by HC to Controller for approval of ex-gratia (\$5k -> \$25k)



Main changes (continued)

Procurement

Including all UN Rules on procurement with minor adjustments to reflect UNHCR terms. UNHCR already applies those, but they were not embedded in UNHCR rules.

Simplified language on Working Capital Fund for Voluntary Contributions to reflect current UNHCR processes and aligning to UN Regs

Working Capital Fund



Improvements from updating UNHCR financial rules:



Reduced risk of misinterpretation and increased clarity over the application of the financial framework of governing UN Financial Regulations and UNHCR financial rules




Improved basis for training and accountability at all levels
