

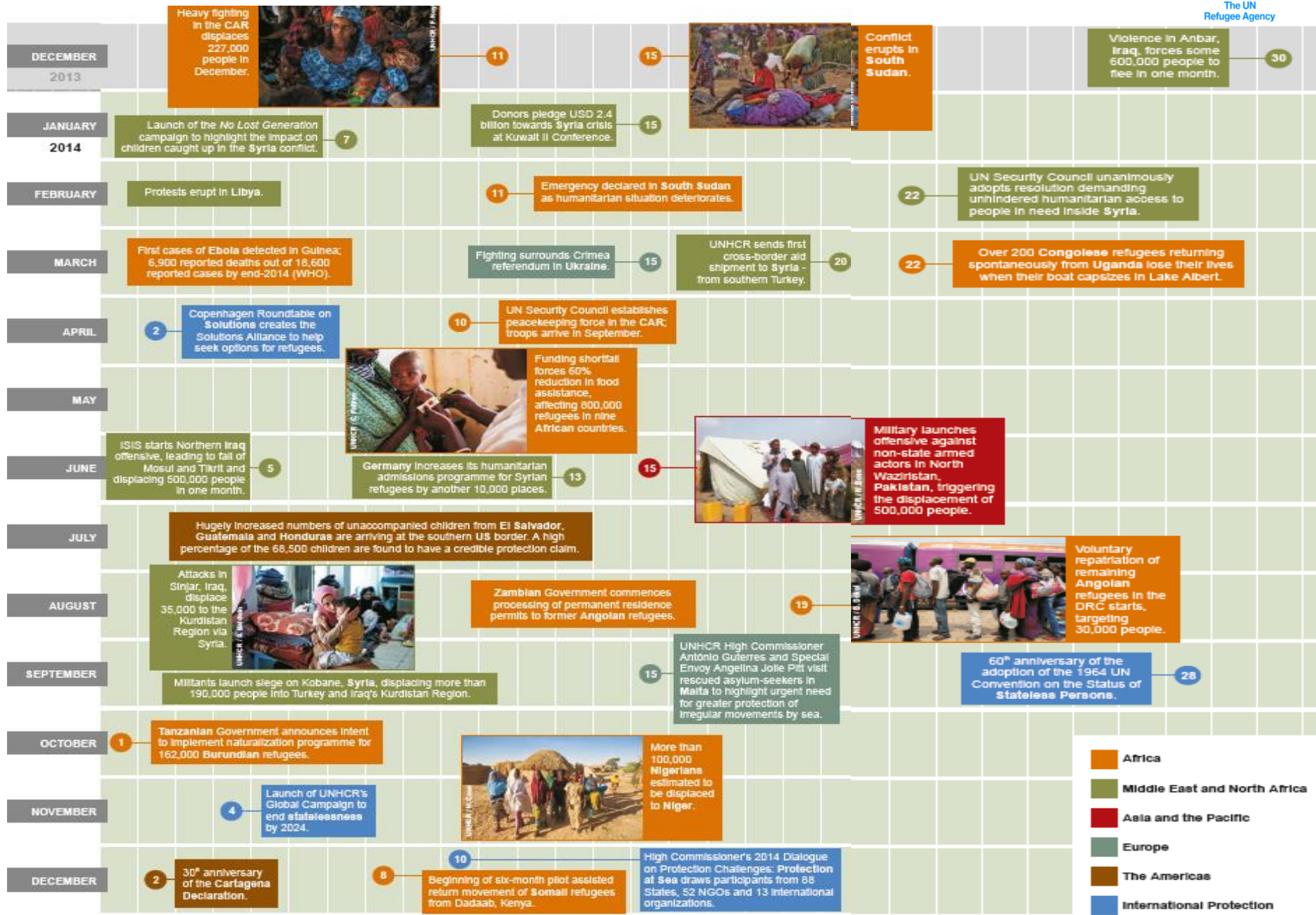

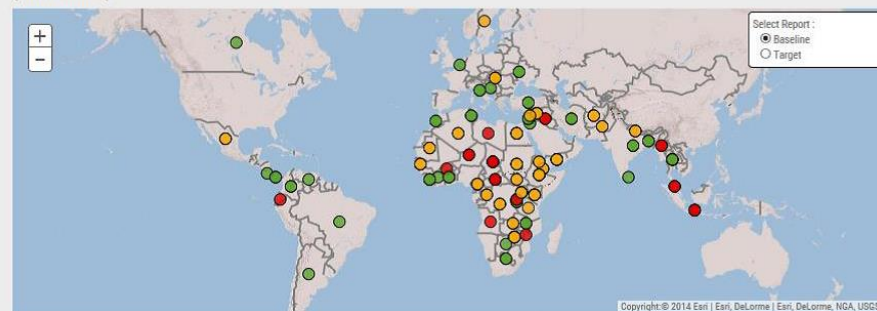

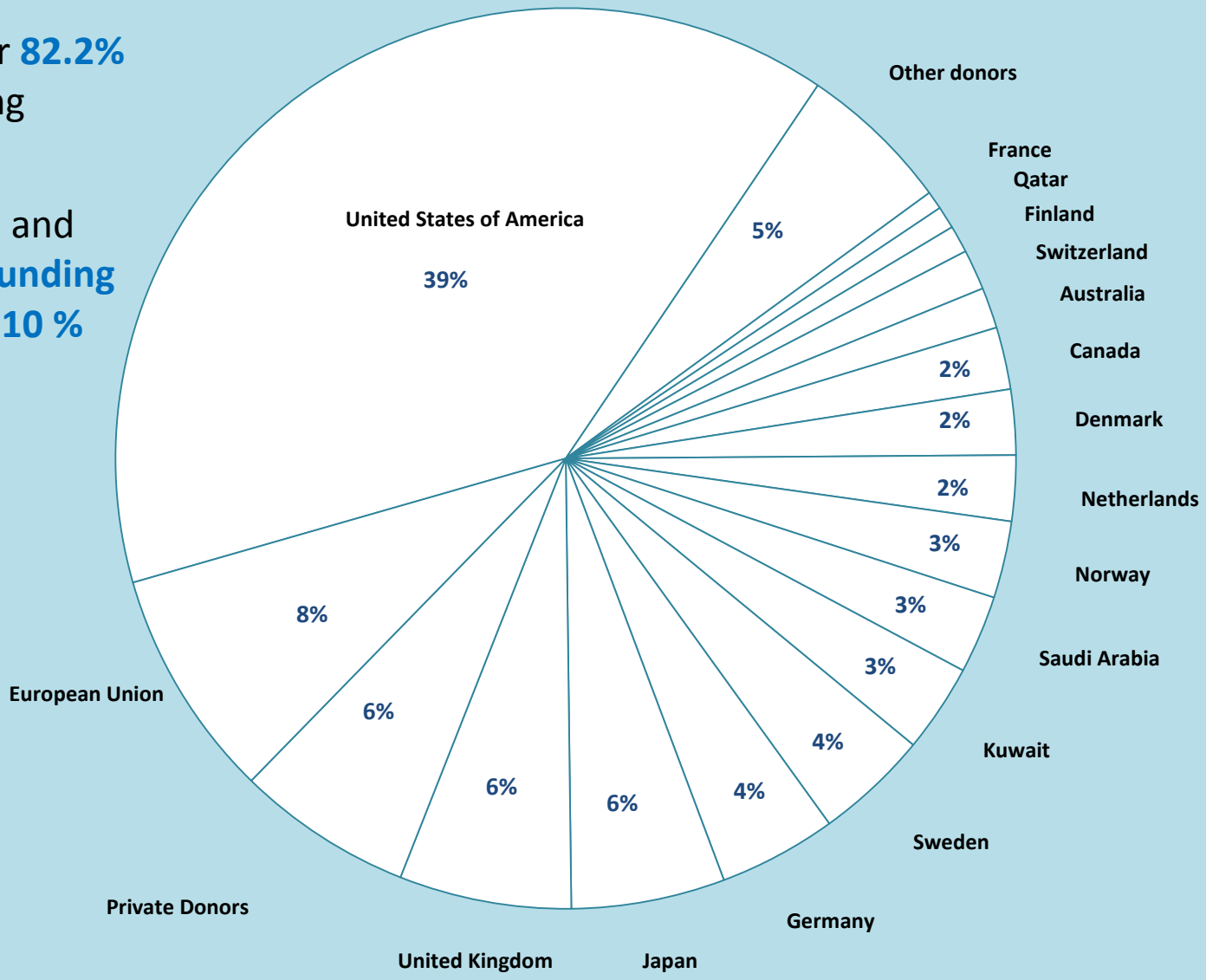


Funding UNHCR's programmes
