

WHO Statement Formal Consultations on the Global Compact on Refugees
Geneva, February 14 2018

Thank you Assistant High Commissioner and Madame Co-chair,

WHO would like to express its full support for the application of the CRRF under the leadership of UNHCR.

WHO would like to reiterate our commitment to improving our capabilities at country level particularly making reference to point 1.1 the preparedness element functions and different interventions to put in place in order to address refugee health needs and support Member States capacities.

We would like to see reflected in this Global Compact a more robust reference to health interventions and WHO's role better defined as a leading health coordinating UN agency.

We are ready to step up our contributions in both emergency setting as well as protracted situations reinforcing the concept of moving away from past practices of parallel services for refugees and encourage the



expansion and national health system strengthening for both host communities and refugees.

As mentioned yesterday WHO will continue to strive to improve our coordination in emergency settings, health system strengthening and access to Universal Health Care for all, a Strategic priority in our Global Program of Work.

We will be providing more specific comments in writing in due course.
